What is Bright Horizons® FastTrack?

Bright Horizons FastTrack is an EdAssist product powered by Straighterline. It is an online education platform that allows working learners to earn their general education credits quickly and cost-effectively. The courses available through Bright Horizons FastTrack are endorsed by the American Council of Education (ACE) and the credits earned transfer to accredited university partners.

What courses are available in FastTrack?

Over 60 general education courses including Business, English, Health Science, Humanities, Languages, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Technology and more.

I have an articulation agreement with Straighterline, does Bright Horizon's FastTrack fall under that agreement?

Yes, Bright Horizon's FastTrack is a white labeled program that falls under your articulation agreement with Straighterline.

Will I be getting transcripts from Straighterline or Bright Horizon's FastTrack?

Straighterline but for participants with clinical pathways, the transcript will come from the American College of Education.

How do I accept the credits?

According to your credit acceptance policy and agreement with Straighterline, the credits will follow the same acceptance process.

Does FastTrack accept transcripts for prior credits?

No, learners are advised to send transcripts to the university partner for evaluation of transfer credits prior to enrolling with FastTrack. If the university partner accepts the transfer credit, the learner will mark the course(s) as completed in the FastTrack platform.

What is the difference between Education Access and Bright Horizon's FastTrack?

Education Access is a Bright Horizon's prepackaged solution that provides an affordable path to a bachelor's degree for any participant, starting from any education level. That solution includes our white labeled Straighterline product, Bright Horizon's FastTrack. Bright Horizon's FastTrack is an online education offering where participants can progress on general education credits before getting their bachelor's degree. The typical path for a participant will be Bright Horizon's FastTrack leading into one of the university partners.
