



Earning Credit for What You Know

HUB SUPERVISOR TRAINING SCHOOL (HSTS)

Full-time employees who successfully complete HSTS (since May 2012) and enroll in the University may be awarded 12 credits toward an undergraduate degree or certificate.

If you completed the HSTS program between June 1998 and April 2012 and enroll in the University, you may be awarded 9 credits toward an undergraduate degree or certificate.

INTEGRAD-MANAGING PERFORMANCE TRAINING

If you have successfully completed the workshop and all of the post-course activities (from January 2011 through present) and enroll in the University, you may be awarded up to 8 credits toward an undergraduate degree.

DRIVER TRAINING SCHOOL

If you completed the Driver Training School (from January 2011 through present) and enroll in the University, you may be awarded 6 elective credits toward an undergraduate degree or certificate.

LICENSES AND CERTIFICATIONS

Thomas Edison State University awards academic credit for more than 120 professional licenses and certifications, including:

TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

UPSSers eligible for the UPS Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) will be reimbursed for 100 percent of undergraduate tuition paid to the University.

THE VOUCHER PROGRAM

UPSSers eligible for the UPS Tuition Voucher Program may use the voucher for 100 percent of undergraduate tuition paid to the University.
